- ⇒ Mohammad K: Lower and less injuries with skateboards and roller skates than bicycles. Bicycles are allowed, but these other modes of transportation are safer and not allowed currently.
- ⇒ Alysa N: SSF conducted a survey last week for one week. We got 145 responses. Overwhelmingly percent of those people were not aware that other forms of transportation were banned.
