**Student Governance Syllabus Resolution**

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**Sponsors:** De Anza Associated Student Body Senate

**WHEREAS**, the De Anza Associated Student Body (DASB) and the elected student trustee represent the De Anza student population in shared governance processes at the college and district levels;

**WHEREAS**, legitimate democratic student representation is possible only when students are informed of legislative processes and know their rights;

**WHEREAS**, De Anza College students pay a student representation fee that was in-stated by DASB and, in part, funds DASB activities, representing a direct investment by students in DASB;

**WHEREAS**, course professors are the primary point of contact for De Anza College students, and the model syllabus provided to professors includes information that is considered of significant interest to students; and

**WHEREAS** the school has the responsibility and imperative to support shared governance representation of all students, and classes are the only guaranteed way to reach all students;

now, therefore, let it be

**RESOLVED**, the following statement will be included in the model syllabus provided to all De Anza College professors, for recommended inclusion in course syllabi:

**De Anza Associated Student Body Senate**

De Anza College students are represented in College, and District governance processes by elected student representatives. The De Anza Associated Student Body Senate funds programs, clubs, and events across campus, and defends the rights of students.

Student elections are held every spring and fall quarter, and meetings are held on Wednesdays at 4 p.m. in the student council chambers in the lower level of the Hinson Campus Center. Students are encouraged to attend meetings, make public comments, and vote in elections.
