## PRESIDENT SEARCH COMMITTEE

- > Consider search committee appointments that reflect diversity in areas such as race, ethnicity, gender/orientation, and longevity at De Anza, and that you put forward representatives who have a demonstrated commitment to equity and a willingness to be informed by the assessment and visioning process she has initiated.
- > Represent different areas for Classified Staff (we have members from four unions)
- > Represent different focus/job areas on the campus
- > CS, Union and/or Shared Governance experience

## PRESIDENT SEARCH COMMITTEE

- > Process in accordance with our Bylaws:
  - Collect names of those interested
  - Verify people can commit to the schedule and EEO training
  - Executive Council explore the full list to look for diversity and equity/balance in unions and work areas. Contact made with individuals if there are questions.
  - Executive Council narrows the list to 5 nominees plus 1 alternative.
  - Final vote/confirmation by Classified Senate on October 22.
