Subject: Summer Bridge - Umoja

In summer 2016, participants of De Anza College's Summer Bridge program were provided the opportunity to participate in the Summer Bridge Survey from Student Success and Retention Services (SSRS). Participants were asked which other SSRS programs they had interest in. This resulted in 21 responses to SSRS's Umoja Program survey.


Important highlights include:

- While 33% of participants agreed their high school had the resources necessary to prepare them for a college education, only 19% of participants agreed that they were satisfied with the college guidance and counseling they received in high school (Question 3a, 3c).
- 29% of participants listed that a family member had encouraged them as their primary reason to attend De Anza (Question 7).
- 71% of participants strongly agree their mother is supportive of their decision to attend De Anza College, and 48% strongly agree their father is supportive of their decision (Question 9, 10).
- 67% of participants are often distracted by their family members when studying at home (Question 12).
- 52% of participants live more than 10 miles away from De Anza College (Question 15).
- 57% of participants plan to drive themselves to De Anza for Summer Bridge, and 43% plan to take public transportation (Question 16).
- 71% of participants plan to drive themselves to De Anza for Fall term (Question 17).









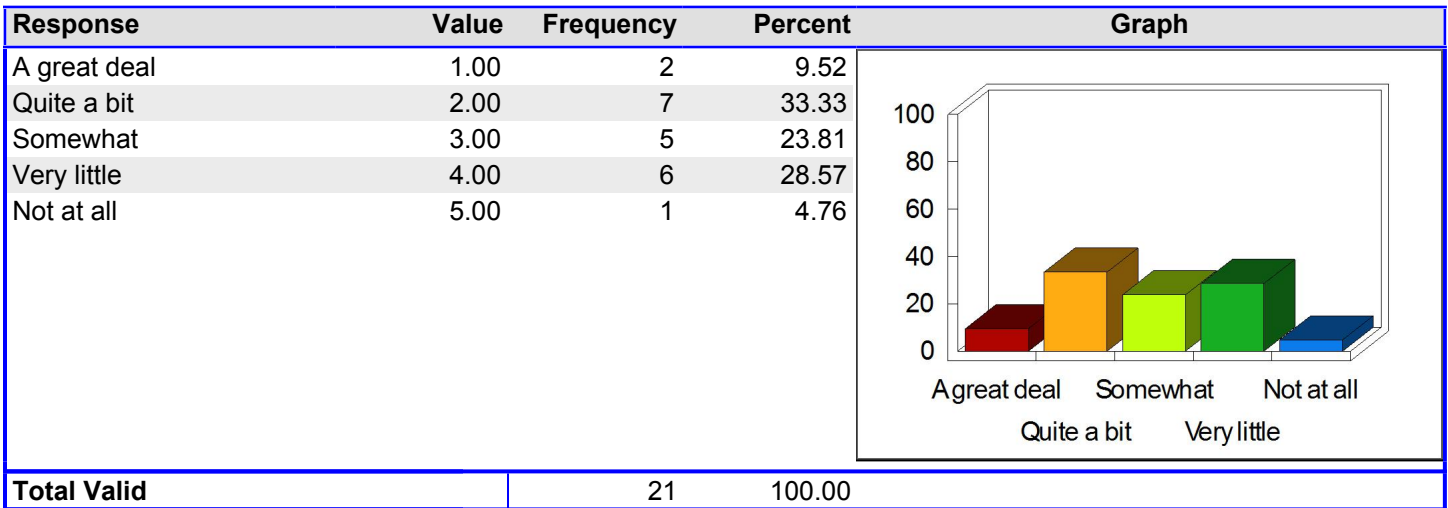

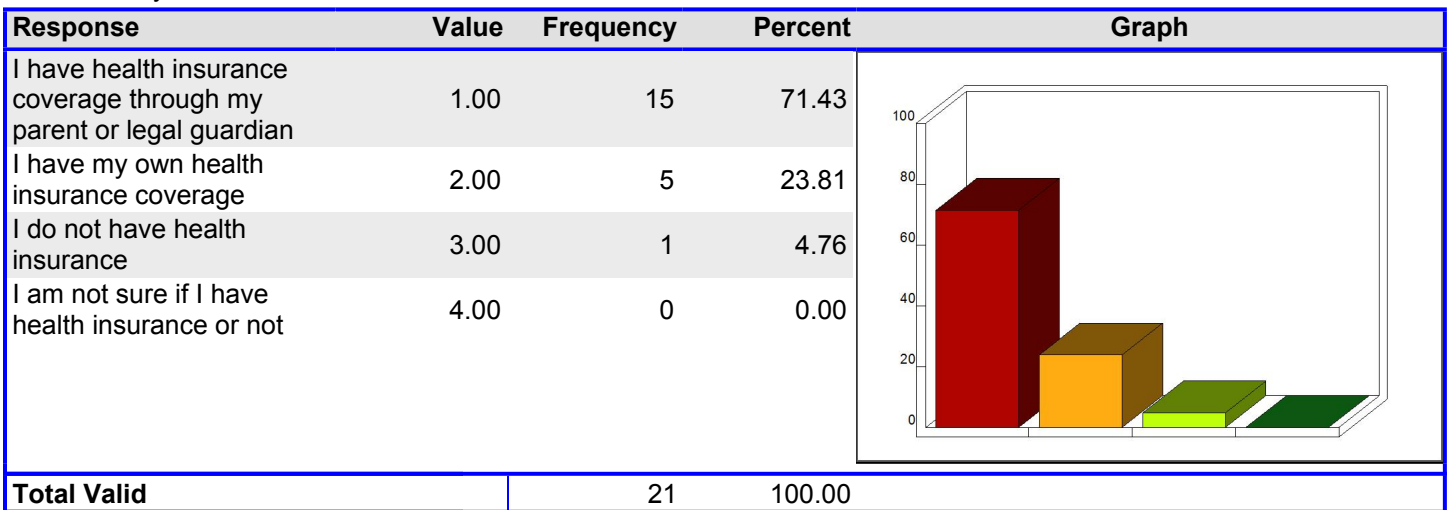
12. When studying at home, how often are you distracted by your family members?

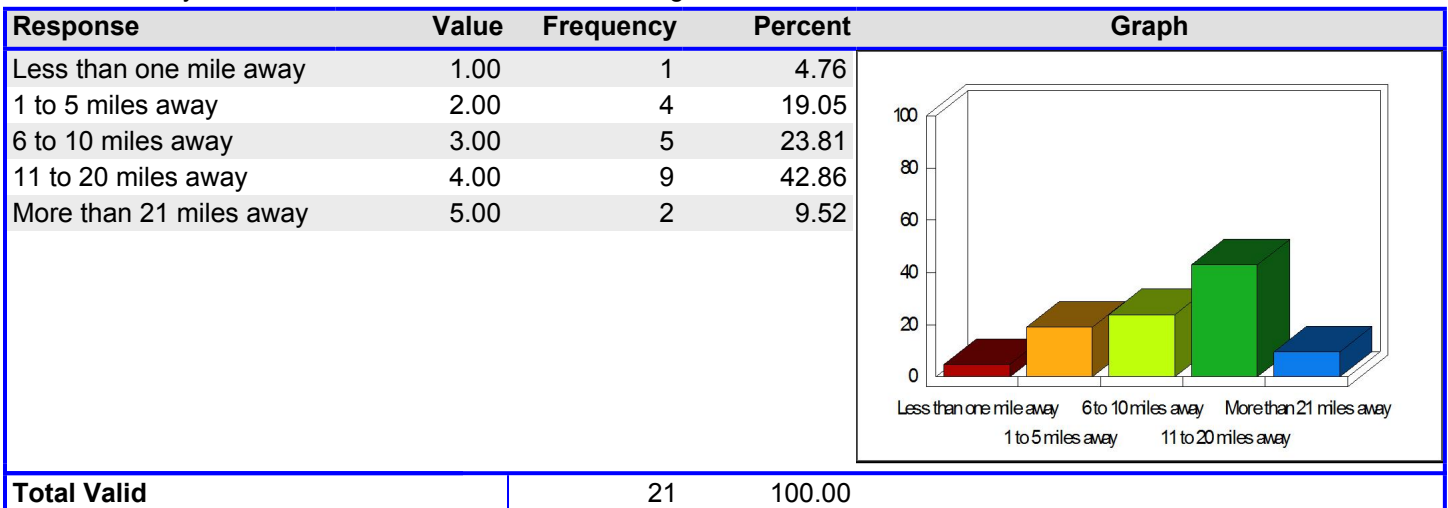
14. What is your current health insurance status?
