Prerequisite: Qualifying score on Math Placement Test within the last calendar year; or Math 212.

Book: MyMathLab software along with the textbook Intermediate Algebra for College Students, 5th edition, by Blitzer.

Materials: A graphing calculator is recommended. You need to bring the textbook to class. Keep some graphing paper with you at all times.
