

Weekly Individual Tutoring for the Algebras

What?

Weekly individual tutoring is a quarter-long commitment, which consists of one-on-one tutoring sessions with a designated tutor for one hour per week. All algebra students signing up for weekly individual tutoring will also be required to complete a math study skills packet consisting of short exercises to be completed before each of your tutoring sessions. An important component to your success as a student is exercising effective studying strategies on a regular basis. We're here to help!

Who?

All math 210, 212 and 114 students taking advantage of the MSTRC's weekly individual tutoring will be signing a contract and completing a study skills packet on an independent basis prior to the tutoring sessions. All other students are encouraged to participate to learn new tips and tricks for effective studying and test-taking!

The Student Success Center's MSTRC is committed to your success and teaching you how to implement successful study strategies on a regular basis in your present and future math and science courses. Past statistics have shown that the average passing rate for Math 210, 212 and 114 students was 56%, while 27% did not pass, and 17% withdrew. We want you and your classmates to succeed in these and all of your classes. Resources are limited, so we are requiring that you make a quarter-long commitment to our improved one-on-one tutorial services. Please, help us help you!

When?

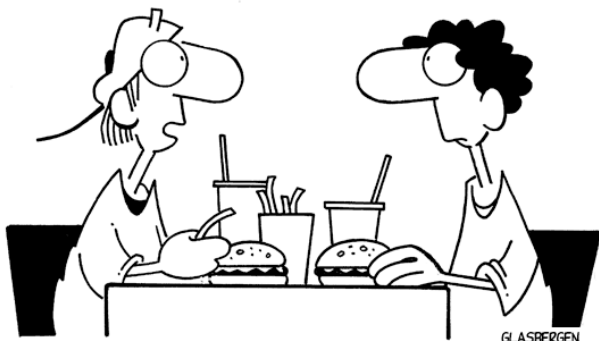

How?

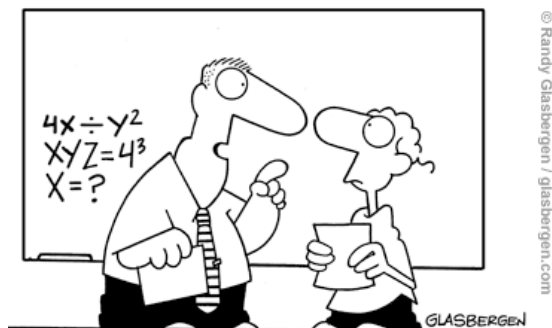
To apply for weekly individual tutoring visit our center or do the following:
